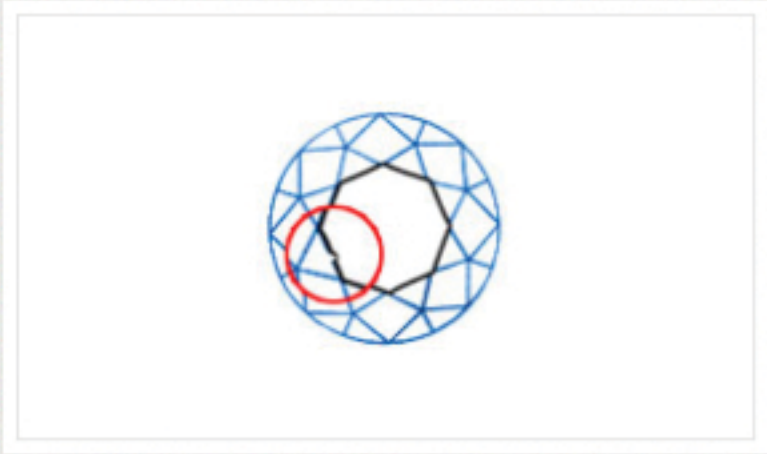


OPENS (OP)

This term is used to indicate open position in diamond if there is any open on the surface of diamonds. This is subdivided in three parts: - (1) OPTA = Open on Table, (2) OPCR = Open on Crown, (3) OPPV = Open on Pavilion.

Open on Table (OPTA)



CODE	DESCRIPTION
(01) – VERY SMALL	Difficult to see and it is dependent on the clarity grade.
(02) – SMALL	Easy to see as compared to very small and it is dependent on the clarity grade.
(03) – HEAVY	Easily seen and it is dependent on the clarity grade.

Open on Crown (OPCR)



CODE	DESCRIPTION
(01) – VERY SMALL	Difficult to see and it is dependent on the clarity grade.
(02) – SMALL	Easy to see as compared to very small and it is dependent on the clarity grade.
(03) – HEAVY	Easily seen and it is dependent on the clarity grade.

Open on Pavilion (OPPV)



CODE	DESCRIPTION
(01) – VERY SMALL	Difficult to see and it is dependent on the clarity grade.
(02) – SMALL	Easy to see as compared to very small and it is dependent on the clarity grade.
(03) – HEAVY	Easily seen and it is dependent on the clarity grade.

These ratings are dependent on the maximum Open for every diamond in each clarity grade and are visible with 10X magnification.
